


Nebraska Stories of Humanity StoryMap Activity

Directions: You will create a StoryMap about the 10 artifacts you have curated from the Nebraska Stories of Humanity Collection.

Each artifact should include a picture and a brief description. Consider the different types of map options that you could create to show your artifacts in spatial terms.

A. Create an Account on [StoryMaps](https://storymaps.com)

1. Log into storymaps.com

2. Click "Create" in the top right

5. Once you are finished click "Publish" and change the visibility to "Anyone with the Link"
